

Great Oak Co-Housing

This award winning 40-unit condominium development is based on the Danish concept of cohousing. It is the second cohousing project completed by Sunstructures Architects and only the second cohousing project in Michigan. The residential complex is designed to promote community with shared spaces and activities, including weekly meals served in the 5,000 SF Common House.

Sunstructures Architects interacted with all 40 households, Township officials, and Landscape and Site Engineering subcontractors. The project was featured by the Huron River Watershed Council as an outstanding example of on-site water conservation using bio-swales, storm water retention, and several acres of native prairie.
